## WEATHERFAST SATIN WHITE

**DESCRIPTION:** A single pack, low-odour Satin finish enamel with excellent weathering characteristics in

salt laden environments.

**USES:** Can be used on most surfaces including timber, steel, aluminium and concrete, as long

as they are primed and properly prepared.

## PROPERTIES (at 20°C)

**TOXICITY:** See "Precautions".

FINISH: Satin gloss

**COVERAGE:** 10 - 12 square meters per litre.

**DRYING TIME:** Touch dry - 2 hours at 50% relative humidity.

CLEAN UP: Weatherfast Brushing Thinner

**PREPARATION:** New Timber – Prime with NORGLASS PRI-COAT and follow with a further 1-2

coats, allowing 24 hours (minimum) drying between coats.

Finish with 2 coats of Weatherfast Satin White.

**OTHER SUBSTRATES**: Refer to appropriate NORGLASS product

Information sheets.

**Previously painted surfaces** – require cleaning down with, removal of flaking or unsound paint and sanding with 220-360 grit sandpaper to remove any existing

aloss.

**APPLICATION:** Stir contents before use.

Apply by brush, short nap roller or by spray.

In hot weather a maximum of 5% Weatherfast Brushing Thinner

may be added to assist brushing.

For conventional spray equipment, thin up to 33 1/3% at 50-60 PSI with Norglass Weatherfast Spraying Thinners. For other spray equipment use less

spraying thinners according to the unit recommendations.

TRANSPORTATION: Dangerous Goods class 3.2

**PRECAUTIONS**; Provide adequate ventilation during use.

Wear correct apparatus when applying by spray.

Do not use on areas of constant immersion.

The use of yellows and oranges are notoriously difficult to obtain coverage when applied over a less than uniform background. Any patchy areas will still show through after several coats of Northane or Weatherfast enamel. This is a problem with all yellow and orange lead free pigments regardless of manufacturer. The only solution is to make sure the background colour is completely uniform before painting i.e. uniformly white, grey, blue Etc.
